


SH 199 CORRIDOR MASTER PLAN OPEN HOUSE

WITH BRIEF PRESENTATION AT 6:15 PM



The SH 199 corridor (from IH 820 to downtown Fort Worth) was identified as a vital regional transportation facility in *Planning for Livable Military Communities*, with visionary concepts to balance mobility and accessibility improvements with economic development.

As a next step, a corridor master plan study for SH 199 is being developed to advance these visions into a design. The corridor master plan will use context sensitive solution principles and modern engineering concepts to



recommend phased improvements to increase the livability in the corridor, provide transportation options for different users and improve drainage. The corridor master plan will study many elements such as landscaping and streetscaping, intersection improvements, water runoff and drainage, economic market analysis, parking, bicycle and pedestrian improvements, public transportation and roadway widening.
