

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING


The City of Fort Worth, Texas will conduct a public hearing in accordance with Chapter 26, Texas Parks and Wildlife Code, concerning the use of parkland for the purpose of the dedication of public road rights of way and construction of the extension of Trail Drive, the proposed Van Zandt Lane, and intersection and related infrastructure improvements at University Drive, and for the installation of a water line in the following parks:

**Fort Worth Botanic Garden** - located at 2000 University Drive, Mapsco, 76E and 76J, south of Harley Street, north of Interstate Highway 30 West, west of University Drive and east of Montgomery Street; in Council District 3 & 7

**Trinity Park** - located at 2401 University Drive, Mapsco: 76B, 76C, 76E, 76F and 76J, southwest of the Clear Fork Trinity River, south access IH 30 West, east of University Drive, intersected by Crestline Road, south of terminus of Foch Street, intersected Lancaster Avenue, east of Museum Way, south of 7th Street, in Council District 9.

The public hearing will be held at the regularly scheduled **City Council Meeting, August 29, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber**, second floor, City Hall, 200 Texas Street, Fort Worth, 76102.
