D. Continued Cases

1. BAC-17-076 <u>SEJ Assett by Tommy Bell</u> 2945 & 2961 W. Berry Street

- a. Request a **SPECIAL EXCEPTION** in the "BU-SH4" Berry University Shopfront District with 4 stories to permit the installation of electronic changeable copy on a monument sign located:
 - i. Along the eastern University Drive frontage, and
 - ii. Along the southern W. Berry Street frontage.

2. BAC-18-003 CT017 Westcliff TX LLC by Hussain Contractor/Ezzi Signs

3548 South Hills Avenue

- a. Request a **VARIANCE** in an "E" Neighborhood Commercial District to permit the construction of a monument sign 25 feet in height that exceeds the maximum height of 8 feet by 17 feet.
- b. Request a **VARIANCE** in an "E" Neighborhood Commercial District to permit the construction of a monument sign with 400 square feet of area that exceeds the maximum area of 128 square feet by 272 square feet.

3. BAC-18-002 Houston Copart Salvage Auto Auction

834 Blue Mound Road West

a. Request an **APPEAL** of a City Official's decision that the business at 834 Blue Mound Road West is not a legal non-conforming vehicle junkyard in a "J" Medium Industrial District.

4. BAC-18-009 Fort Growth Partners by Shana Crawford

101 Nursery Lane

a. Request a **VARIANCE** in a "MU-1" Low Intensity Mixed-Use District to permit the construction of a commercial building with a 30-foot front yard setback, where a 20-foot front yard setback is the maximum allowed, excessive by 10 feet.

5. BAC-18-010 <u>Elevate Credit by Signs Manufacturing & Maintenance Corporation</u> 4150 International Plaza

- Request a VARIANCE in a "G" Intensive Commercial District to permit the construction of an attached sign 418 square feet in area that would exceed the maximum area for the north facade (southern building) of 375 square feet by 43 square feet.
- b. Request a **VARIANCE** in a "G" Intensive Commercial District to permit the construction of an attached sign 418 square feet in area that would exceed the maximum area for the east facade (southern building) of 187 square feet by 231 square feet.

6. BAC-18-011 Forestar Real Estate Group by North Texas Inspection Services 300 Deserado Drive

a. Request a **VARIANCE** in an "A-5" One-Family District to permit the conversion of a single family residence into a model home less than 300 feet from an occupied residence.



7. BAC-18-012 <u>Museum Place Block B, Ltd. by Ray Oujesky, Kelly Hart & Hallman</u> 3214 & 3230 Camp Bowie Boulevard

- a. Request a **VARIANCE** in the "MU-2" High Intensity Mixed-Use District to permit the construction of a 9 story building, excessive by 2 stories.
- b. Request a **VARIANCE** in the "MU-2" High Intensity Mixed-Use District to provide 285 parking spaces, where 241 spaces would be the maximum allowed, excessive by 44 parking spaces.

8. BAC-18-014 Bower & Parker Investments, Inc. by Star Towers, LLC 4401 Carev Street

a. Request a **VARIANCE** in an "I" Light Industrial District to permit the construction of a 125-foot telecommunications tower that exceeds the maximum height of 75 feet by 50 feet.

9. BAC-18-015 G&J Brillhart Inc. by Barnett Signs - Tommy Bell 3505 Heritage Trace Parkway

a. Request a **SPECIAL EXCEPTION** in an "E" Neighborhood Commercial District to permit the installation of electronic changeable copy on a monument sign.
