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## SUBJECT: FY2020 TO FY2021 DEPARTMENT BUDGET COMPARISONS REFLECTING FY2020 REORGANIZATIONS

During FY2020, the City reorganized several departments and also shifted or repurposed positions to other departments. These changes included the establishment of Development Services and Planning & Data Analytics, which impacted several departments including Transportation & Public Works and Human Resources. In addition, positions from Municipal Court were moved to the City Attorney's Office to better align responsibilities and to the City Manager's Office for a Police Monitor position. Finally, the Business Diversity Program was transferred from Economic Development to the Diversity & Inclusion Department.

FY2020 budgets were not moved to reflect these mid-year reorganizations, making it difficult to accurately compare the FY2020 budget to the FY2021 recommended budget. The following table incorporates the reorganizations into the FY2020 budget to reflect the true change from year to year.
