Keep Fort Worth Beautiful's Annual Fall Cleanup Event

What is Neighborhood Litter Stomp?

Neighborhood Litter Stomp is a citywide volunteer litter cleanup hosted by Keep Fort Worth Beautiful every fall. We want our residents and businesses to focus on beautifying their surrounding community. Encourage your friends, family and neighbors to pick up litter at their local park, school or block.



What are the goals for this event?

Keep Fort Worth Beautiful works to ensure our city is a clean, green, and beautiful place to live. No one individual can do this alone. It takes all of us. This is why we invite people like you to participate in our activities and support our programs.

The heart of KFWB is our volunteers. Last year, volunteers removed over 20,000 pounds of litter and debris from our community during this event!

Who can participate?

Everyone! Community organizations, businesses, individuals, non-profit, governmental agencies, and scout troops all are welcome to participate in this event.

What ages can participate?

Youth, teens and adults are welcome to participate.

What is the cost to participate?

There is no cost to participate.

KFWB provides gloves and trash bags to all registered participants. Event t-shirts are also provided to registrants while supplies last.

Can volunteers choose a location to clean up?

Yes. Volunteers are encouraged to choose a location that is important to them. Locations can include school campuses, creeks and other waterways, or even empty lots. KFWB also chooses various hubs throughout the city. This year, hub locations are Lake Como Park, Eugene McCray Park at Lake Arlington, and Marion Samson Park. Volunteers are welcome to register for a hub location.

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New to Litter Stomp? Join the fun in cleaning up Fort Worth; it's easy and free to participate!

Before the event:

Step 1. Mark your calendar for October 15 – you can participate by yourself or organize a group.

Step 2. Choose to pick up litter at one of our preselected hub sites or choose any public site you want to clean up.

Step 3. Register as an individual, a family or a group. Registration opens September 1, 2022.

Step 4. Pick up your free t-shirts and cleanup supplies on Friday, October 14 from 9:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. at Hazel Harvey Peace Center for Neighborhoods, 818 Missouri Avenue, Fort Worth, 76104.

On the day of the event:

Step 5. Pick up litter on October 15!

When the event is over, what do I do with the filled trash bags?

Step 6. Take the bags to one of the four Drop-Off Stations or your own trash container.

Vouchers are required if you do not live in Fort Worth city limit or don't have a copy of a water bill. If you live in an apartment you will need to get an event voucher to use the drop-off site.

What is a wrap-up form and why is it important I submit one following the event?

Step 7. Report your efforts with an easy, online form.

After completing your litter cleanup we require a completed wrap-up form to share with our entire community, our government leaders and partners such as Keep Texas Beautiful and Keep America Beautiful. Tracking this data provides metrics on the overall impact our volunteers have on litter and assists us apply for grants/funding opportunities.
