


## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Fort Worth, Texas will conduct a public hearing in accordance with Chapter 26, Texas Parks and Wildlife Code, concerning the use of parkland for the purpose of installing intersection improvements and the dedication of public road rights of way within the following park:

**Forest Park**- located at 1500-2000 Colonial Pkwy., Mapsco 76N, P, & K, south of the Clear Fork Trinity River, west of Rogers St., intersected by University Dr., north and south of Colonial Pkwy., northeast of Winton Terrace, east of terminus of Wescott Rd, intersected by Park Hill Dr., east of Sandage Ave., north of McPherson Ave., west of McCart Ave., west of Forest Park Blvd., intersected by Park Pl., intersected by Colonial Pkwy., west at terminus of Huntington Ln., west of Rockridge Terrace, south of Kensington Ct., west of terminus of Stonebridge Place.

The public hearing will be held at the regularly scheduled **City Council Meeting, March 6, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber**, second floor, City Hall, 200 Texas Street, Fort Worth, 76102.
