



**Intact Pet Permit (Section 6-22.1)**

- 1) The permit is issued to an individual owner. A permit is not transferable to another person.
- 2) To maintain a permit, the permit holder must keep the Animal Care and Control Division apprised of current contact information for holder and identifying, licensing and registration information of all animals included under the permit. In particular, a permit holder must notify the Animal Care and Control Division of any change of address or telephone number no later than ninety (90) days after the new address or phone number is effective. In addition, within ninety days (90) days of obtaining an animal that was not included in the original permit application, the permit holder must provide the Animal Care and Control Division with the species, breed, gender, age and current, valid City license number of each such animal.
- 3) An application may be denied if the applicant:
  - a. Fails to complete the application and/or provide required documentation;
  - b. Fails to pay the required fee or attend the Responsible Pet Ownership Class;
  - c. Provides false information on the application;
  - d. Has, within the preceding twenty-four (24) months, been convicted, received deferred adjudication, or pleaded guilty or no contest with respect to any City or state law relating to the care and humane treatment of animals or animal cruelty;
  - e. Has previously had a permit revoked or resides at the same physical address as another individual whose permit has been revoked;
  - f. If the Animal Care and Control Division determines that specific circumstances exist indicating that issuance of the permit would not be in the best interest of the animals involved or of the health and safety of the public. If so, the Division shall issue a written statement citing the specific reason(s) for the denial.
- 4) A permit may be revoked if:
  - a. Is convicted, receives deferred adjudication, or pleads guilty or no contest with respect to any City or state law relating to the care and humane treatment of animals or animal cruelty;
  - b. Fails to appear in court to respond to a citation relating to an alleged violation of any City or state law relating to the care and humane treatment of animals or animal cruelty;
  - c. Is discovered to have provided false or inaccurate information on or in connection with the original permit application;
  - d. Fails to license or vaccinate any animal as required by law;
  - e. Fails to maintain the permit as stated above.

**By applying for this permit, I swear, or affirm, under penalty of perjury that all information contained in this intact pet application is true and correct and that I accept the responsibilities of owning an intact pet and agree to comply with all animal control ordinances as defined in the Fort Worth Municipal Code.**
