One temporary sign per business and no more than two per platted lot in commercial and industrial districts, including portable signs parked on property

YES!

Each sign can remain in place for up to 30 days and can be up to 60 square feet.

YES!

After each 30 day period, at least 30 days without temporary signage must occur.

Is it okay to put temporary banners and signs all over my business?

Can I place as many temporary signs and banners advertising products and services on my business property as I please?

NO!

In general, the City of Fort Worth allows only one temporary sign per business and no more than two per platted lot in commercial and industrial districts. This includes portable signs parked on your property and banners. Each sign can remain in place for no more than 30 days and can be no larger than 60 square feet. After each 30 day period, at least 30 days without temporary signage must occur.



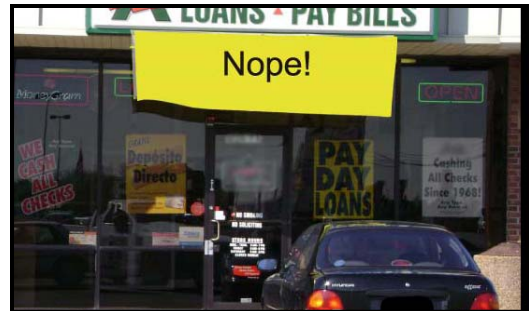
Why does the City restrict temporary signs on private property?

Temporary signs are often deteriorated and result in disarray that blights our neighborhoods. Appropriate signage that doesn't overwhelm a property and allows visibility into storefronts for safety promotes strong and attractive neighborhoods.

Can I just put the signs up without permission?

NOPE!

There is currently a permit required for portable signs and banners. They can be obtained by calling 817-392-2327. There is currently a permit required for portable signs and banners. Permits can be obtained by registered sign erectors by calling 817-392-2327. Permits can be obtained by the property owners/tenants for banners under 60 square feet and lower than 20 feet above the ground.



Can I cover the windows of my business with advertising messages?

NO WAY!

If the messages are affixed to the windows with vinyl lettering, interior rosters, etc., they may not exceed 10% of the window area. (max calculated height of 15 feet). These window signs do not require a permit. Other temporary signs on the exterior of the window must follow the rules outlined above.
