The Problem



- Total Cost for Healthcare for The City of Ft. Worth in 2014 is Budgeted to be \$103 million
- Healthcare Costs Since 2008 have Increased 52.1%
- One Factor Contributing to this Increase in Cost is the Estimated 75% or 12,000 Employees, Dependents, and Retirees that DO NOT HAVE a Primary Care Physician




1. Reduce health plan cost without reducing benefits

4. Coordinate Care to Reduce Fragmentation







- Convenient location near City Hall - free parking available
- Enhanced Clinic Access With Same Day Appointments – Adults only (18 and over)
- Clinic Hours: Monday - Friday 8am to 5 pm
- Dedicated Phone Line for COFW **817-566-7466**
- Physician Supervised and Supported Program
- Not for routine care
- Can be used by all employees



For minor health issues where you may not be able to get in to see your primary care doctor and your condition is not urgent or an emergency

Examples include:

- Common infections (Sore or strep throat, Urinary tract and bladder infections, Earaches and ear infections, pink eye)
- Minor fevers
- Upset stomach
- Cough, colds, and flu
- Nasal Congestion
- Allergy Symptoms
- Insect bites
- Minor burns, cuts, and scrapes
- Sprains and Strains



- You call COFW dedicated phone line **817-566-7466**
- Call picked up by a Triage Nurse: a licensed nurse specially trained to assess if you should come to the clinic or go directly to an Emergency Room
- We'll ask about your insurance plan and provide instruction
- Schedule **first available slot same day** with either Dr. Mathur or Elizabeth Price
- Enter the clinic at reception who will direct you to the CareToday reception area – check in
- After your visit you will check out at the same desk you checked in





- **Basic or Basic Plus Plans - \$10** co-pay applies for urgent care/minor health issues
- **Consumer Choice Plan –** Normal deductible and coinsurance apply
- **Not covered by the City of Fort Worth Health Plan?** Yes you can use the clinic but your normal co-pay and deductible apply *if* the insurance plan is accepted by USMD
