



The PID (Fort Worth Improvement District #1) has partnered with the Day Resource Center (DRC) to create a new homelessness outreach service for downtown. If you see a homeless individual who needs assistance, the DRC will send an outreach team to help. This first responder service is designed to be an alternative to calling the Fort Worth Police Department. If you believe that police assistance is needed immediately, call 911.

When the outreach team arrives, they will quickly assess the situation and determine whether a secondary call to the police or EMT service is necessary. They will also stabilize the situation and identify the appropriate service providers. The first responder team can also provide transportation to a primary referral site and suggest options for storing the individual's personal belongings.
