Findings

The current BOLD building is less than half the size it needs to be to meet current standards, without adding any space to an already overcrowded facility. Because neither the facility nor property is owned by the City of Fort Worth, expansion seems unlikely.

The BOLD Library ranks in the bottom one-third in collection turnover, cost per customer contact, operating cost per square foot, and in overall ranking - demonstrating the inefficiencies of operating such a small library.

Recommendations

Reduce hours of operation to 20 per week, with a goal to save \$157,000 annually, beginning in FY 2011.
