FORT WORTH PUBLIC LIBRARY LONG RANGE SERVICE PLAN

- 5% White about 90% less than Fort Worth as a whole
- 87% African American over four times more than Fort Worth as a whole
- 0% American Indian
- 1.4% Asian and Pacific Islander half of Fort Worth as a whole
- 7% Some other or two or more races about 40% of Fort Worth as a whole
- 100 people or 9% of the branch service population self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. They can be of any race or combination of races. This is about one third of Fort Worth as a whole.

Language Spoken at Home for Population Five Years and Over

- 87% speak English
- 10% speak Spanish 40% of the level of Fort Worth as a whole
- 3% speak Asian or Pacific Islander languages 50% more than Fort Worth as a whole

Household and Economic Data

Median income: \$8,000 - only 20% of the median income of Fort Worth as a whole (\$37,074)

Households with income below the poverty level: 283 of 402 households or 70%. This figure is five and a half times the rate of Fort Worth as a whole.
