- 82% White - about one third more than Fort Worth as a whole
- 4% African American - about 80% less than Fort Worth as a whole
- 0.5% American Indian
- 6% Asian and Pacific Islander - over twice Fort Worth as a whole
- 8% Some other or two or more races - less than half of Fort Worth as a whole
  
- 5,671 people or 12% of the branch service population self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. They can be of any race or combination of races. This is about 60% less than Fort Worth as a whole.

- 84% speak English
- 9% speak Spanish - 36% of the level of Fort Worth as a whole
- 5% speak Asian or Pacific Islander languages - over twice the rate of Fort Worth as a whole

**Household and Economic Data**

Median income: \$62,403 - 168% of the median income of Fort Worth as a whole (\$36,074)  
Households with income below the poverty level: 624 of 16,948 households or 4%. This figure is less than one third the rate of Fort Worth as a whole.
