- 62% White
 - 18% African American - about 10% less than Fort Worth as a whole
 - .7% American Indian
 - 3% Asian and Pacific Islander
 - 16% Some other or two or more races
- 32,892 people or 29% of the underserved population self-identify as Hispanic or Latino. They can be of any race or combination of races.

Language Spoken at Home for Population Five Years and Over

- 71% speak English
- 24% speak Spanish
- 3% speak an Asian or Pacific Island language - about one and a half (1.5) times the rate for Fort Worth as a whole

Household and Economic Data

Median income: \$34,687. This level is 7% below the median income for Fort Worth as a whole (\$37,074)

Households with income below the poverty level: 6,799 of 40,422 households or 17%. This figure is about 30% higher than the rate for Fort Worth as a whole.

- About 20% higher percentage than Fort Worth as a whole has less than a high school education
- The percent with a high school education is a little higher than the city as a whole
- A lower percentage has a higher educational degree - about 30% lower than the city as a whole
