The Proposal Form shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the enclosed revised Proposal Form labelled Addendum 1. The revision included fixed prices for SWPPP > 1 acre and Unclassified Excavation by Plan.

The Construction Plans for the subject project are hereby added, removed, or revised as labelled Addendum 1 on the respective sheets.

Sheet 21 Modified the lime stabilization construction note.

Sheet 27 Modified contraction joint spacing.

## REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION AND CLARIFICATIONS TO THE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- 1. Bidder acknowledges they have read the attached Pre-Bid Agenda which was presented at the optional Prebid Conference on January 6, 2021.
- 2. 01 71 23 Construction staking and survey will be performed by the Contractor. These items are considered subsidiary to the various Items bid. Developer's Engineer will provide the necessary control data for Contractor's use.
- 3. Topsoil is required for the parkways in street ROW. It is unsure if onsite materials will comply with 32 91 19. If not, topsoil will have to be imported.
- 4. What is required of the contractor in regards to the SWPPP? The developer is responsible for the SWPPP book, sign posted at jobsite, and initial NOI that was obtained for the early grading permit. Once the contractor has been given the notice to proceed at the preconstruction meeting, the contractor will maintain the SWPPP (and repair if necessary) until work from the contract is complete and punch list addressed. The contractor is responsible for obtaining and paying for their own NOI on Steers before starting work. A reasonable fixed price has been included for the SWPPP > 1 acre bid item to compensate for this fee and the contractor's obligations for the SWPPP.

5. The Unclassified Excavation by Plan bid item was revised to be a fixed unit price paid by lump sum. The developer has already provided a majority of the grading per the early grading permit. It is not known how close those grades are to what is shown on the plans, so an allowance is provided for contractor's use if the completed grading is not within an allowable tolerance.

This Addendum, forms part of the Contract Documents referenced above and modifies the original Contract Documents and Plans. Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided below, on the last page of the Bid Form and acknowledge receipt on the outer envelope of your bid.

A signed copy of this Addendum should be included in the sealed bid envelope at the time of bid submittal. Failure to acknowledge the receipt of this Addendum could cause the subject bidder to be considered "NONRESPONSIVE," resulting in disqualification.
