Forward Home Program



Open to veterans, military who are on active duty, and surviving spouses.

- Rent, mortgage, and utility payments to prevent Texas veterans and their families from becoming homeless.
- Preference will be given to discharged veterans versus active duty; if funds are running out, we will serve veterans first.

Priority Repair Program



The Priority Repair Program helps Fort Worth homeowners in need of emergency or mechanical system home repairs. Repairs are limited to once every 12 months based on eligibility. Priority is given to veterans.

- Accessibility modifications such as ramps, grab bars, bathroom modifications, door widening, and handrails.
- Health and safety repairs such as heating and air, water and sewer, unstable rotten flooring, electrical system failures and leaky roofs.
