500 Throckmorton Street, Unit 530 (H Zoning) **Downtown Urban Design District overlay Council District: 9**

Owner / Applicant: Sada Tower, LLC / Mike Micallef, Reata Restaurant Management co, LLC.

Requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for the following:

- (1) To install new awnings, and repair existing awnings with fabric with no signs on it, along the facades facing Throckmorton and West 4th Streets;
- (2) To install two new non-illuminated wall signs with a waiver from the allocation of sign area standards for ground floor signs on a storefront exceeding 50 linear feet, to allow a wall sign with a square footage of 67.83 square feet, instead of the maximum allowed square footage of 35 square feet.

Downtown Urban Design District overlay

Council District: 9

Owner / Applicant: Hatch Enterprises V, LLC / Sherman Hatch, Hatch Enterprises V, LLC.

Requests a Certificate of Appropriateness for the following:

- (1) For exterior improvements, including new exterior light fixtures around the building, repair of damaged areas of the sidewalks, partial infill of two doors, infill of two doors and wall opening of two new doors, installation of protection film on windows, a new parapet to extend the existing CMU wall facing West 13th Street, removal of structural damaged walls of the northeast corner of the building, installation of a wooden fence to create a new outdoor fenced area, and a new dumpster enclosure with the following waivers:
 - (a) A Waiver from the street tree standards to not install street trees.
 - (b) A waiver from the pedestrian light standards to not install pedestrian lights.
- (2) For two new illuminated wall signs, and the following waivers:

(a) A waiver from the allocation of sign area standards for ground floor signs on a storefront exceeding 50 linear feet, to allow a wall sign with an area of 39.14 square feet and a second sign with an area of 22.13 square feet for a total area of 61.27 square feet, instead of the maximum allowed square footage of 35 square feet.

Staff	Staff presented their report and recommended approval subject to the condition of
Recommendation:	installing a street tree with a tree grate at the corner of Lamar and West 4th Streets. Also,
	staff recommends the applicant reconsider substituting the proposed wooden fence with
	a low brick wall and wooden fence at the top or a brick wall facing West 4th Street and a
	wooden fence facing the alleyway.
	Finally, the staff of the DDRB recommends approval of the proposed signage and waivers.
Support:	The DFWI Design Review Committee recommended approval of the application provided
	the applicant considers two suggestions. The committee acknowledges that this is much
	needed improvement to the property.
	(1) In order for the dog play area to feel more urban, it is recommended that in lieu of a
	wooden fence that it include some of the original brick from the structure that is coming
	down at the base and/or in columns. The base may help from a function standpoint with durability.
	(2) Given the waiver for street trees, the committee would like the applicant to consider
	an open space at that corner for the new tree.
