**Greenway Neighborhood character zone overlay** 

**Council District: 11** 

Owner / Applicant: Rivera Custom Homes, LLC / Keyla Rivera, Rivera Custom

Homes.

Requests a Certificate of Appropriateness to construct a single-family home and the following waivers:

- (a) A waiver from the Driveways and Walkways Standards to allow a 12-foot wide front-entry driveway instead of the maximum of 10 feet wide.
- (b) A waiver from the Building Height, Massing, Orientation, and Setback Standards to allow a garage that is not behind a main structure, which is a site configuration that is not consistent with the configuration and orientation of the existing structures found on the block face.

Staff	Staff presented their report and recommended approval of the waivers because the
Recommendation:	design of the house is consistent with the structures predominantly found on the block
	and neighborhood. Staff encouraged the applicant to restudy the front door to make the
	house more prominent than the garage. Also, staff recommended installing additional
	landscape elements to screen the driveways or repurposing the garage and building a
	driveway on the west side of the property to match the conditions of the adjacent
_	structures.
Support:	The DFWI Design Committee mentioned they understand the unique situation of the
	project. The committee suggested that the applicant:
	1 Restudy the relationship between the front door/porch and garage to make the "house" more prominent than the garage. (Example below).
	2 Decrease the size of the driveway to meet the standard. Also, questioned the need
	for the portion next to the house. They suggested an alternative to paving, such as
	decomposed granite.
