Traffic Calming is the use of physical design features to reduce automobile speeds to improve the quality of life in residential and commercial areas and increase the safety and comfort of walking and bicycling. The Neighborhood Traffic Calming Request process is designed to thoughtfully engage residents in conversations about their traffic safety concerns and to collaborate with them on potential solutions.

Speed cushions (photo below) are the primary traffic calming measures implemented in the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program.



To request traffic calming on your neighborhood street please submit a completed application to TrafficCalming@fortworthtexas.gov. Applications will be reviewed and a determination on whether traffic calming is recommended will be made within 60 business days. Applicants will be contacted within three weeks of application submission to discuss their safety concerns.

NEIGHBORHOOD SUPPORT*

A petition is required to confirm the following:

- 1) All property owners /residents in the primary affected area are aware of the application submittal.
- 2) Two-thirds of property owners/residents support submittal of the application.
- 3) Residents accept that placement of traffic calming designs may be recommended in front of their property, which may impact on-street parking.

*At the conclusion of the 60 business day application review process, Transportation and Public Works will make a determination on whether traffic calming measures are recommended for the requested streets. If traffic calming is recommended, a petition will be provided to the applicant to complete. City staff will populate the necessary property owner information and the applicant will have responsibility for securing signatures.
