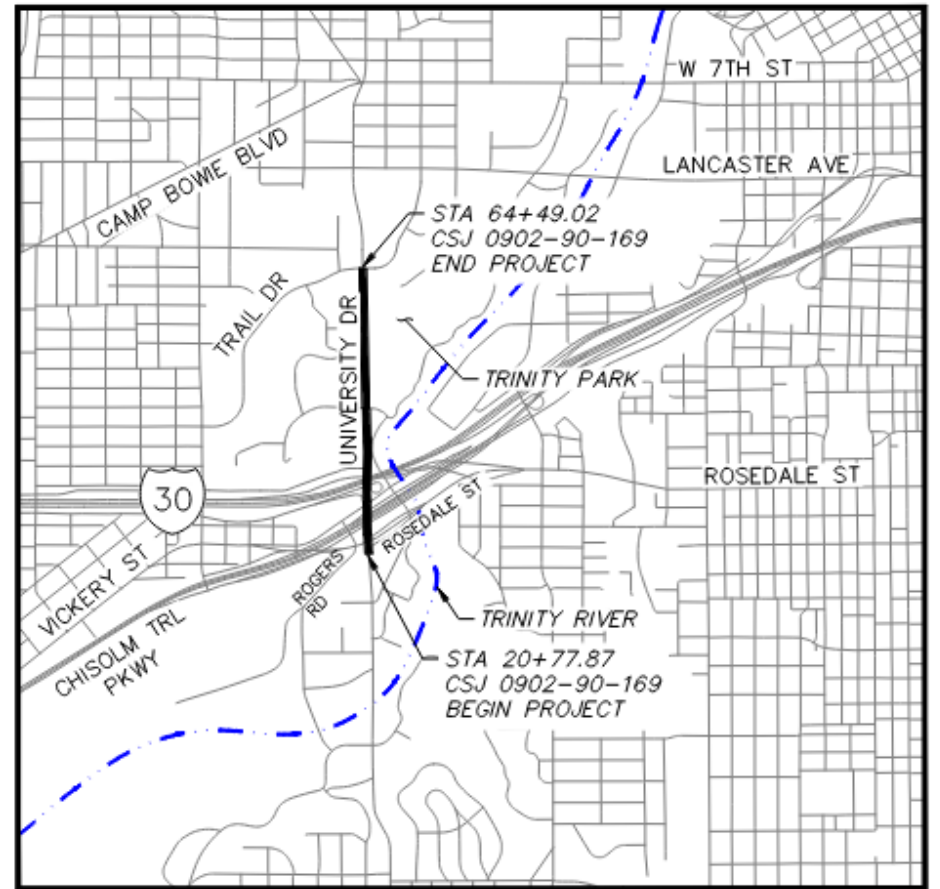

## Project Information

- From Trail Drive to Rosedale Bridge
- Approximately 0.83 miles in length
- Ultimate ROW of variable width
- Design Speed = 40 MPH

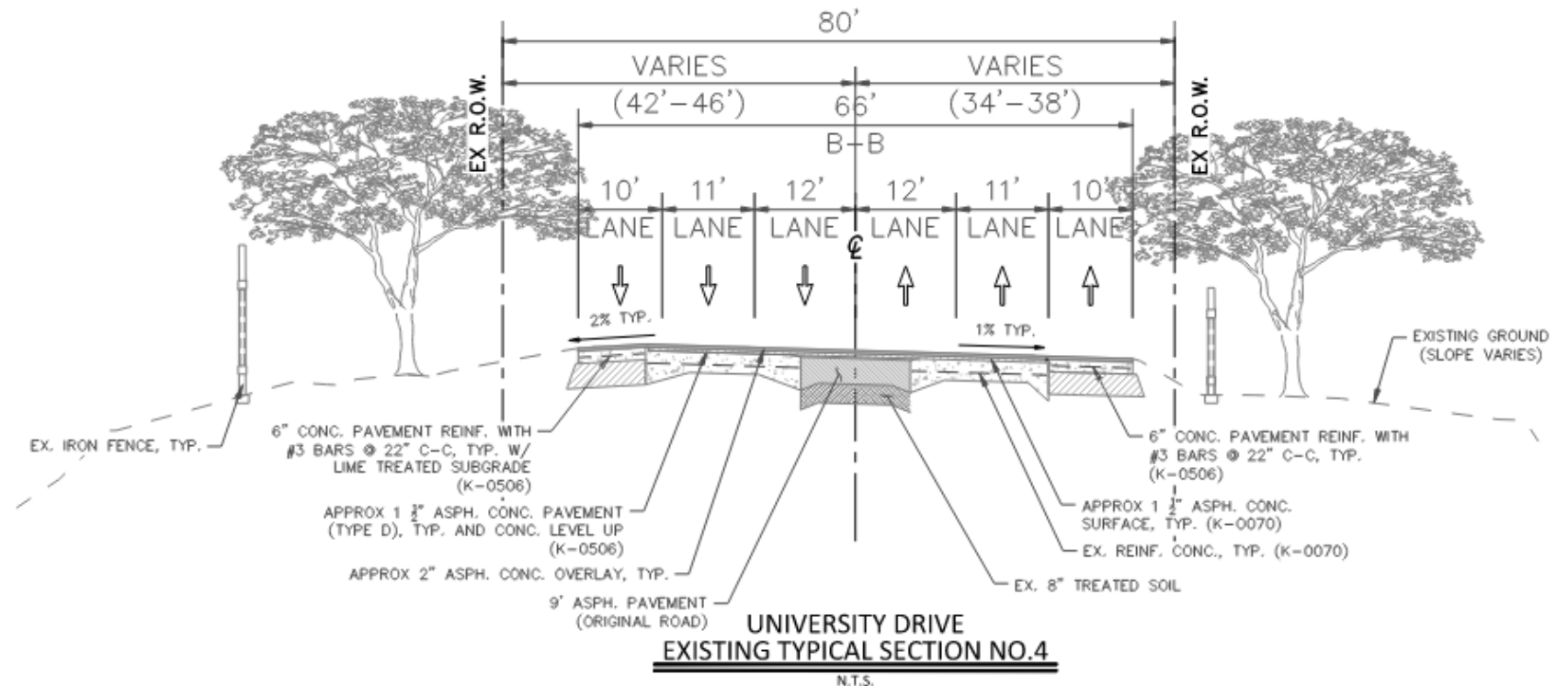
# *Project Goals & Improvements*

- Improvement goals include:
  - Improve safety
  - Improve aesthetics
  - Improving mobility
  - Enhancing roadway operation
- A new six-foot sidewalk on the west side of University Drive from Trail Drive to Rock Springs Road
- Crosswalk improvements and new traffic signals at the intersection of University Dr and Botanic Garden Blvd, and University Dr and Rock Springs Road
- A new median to improve safety
- Streetlights under the bridges near I-30
- Landscaping and directional signage
- Pavement resurfacing and new pavement markings



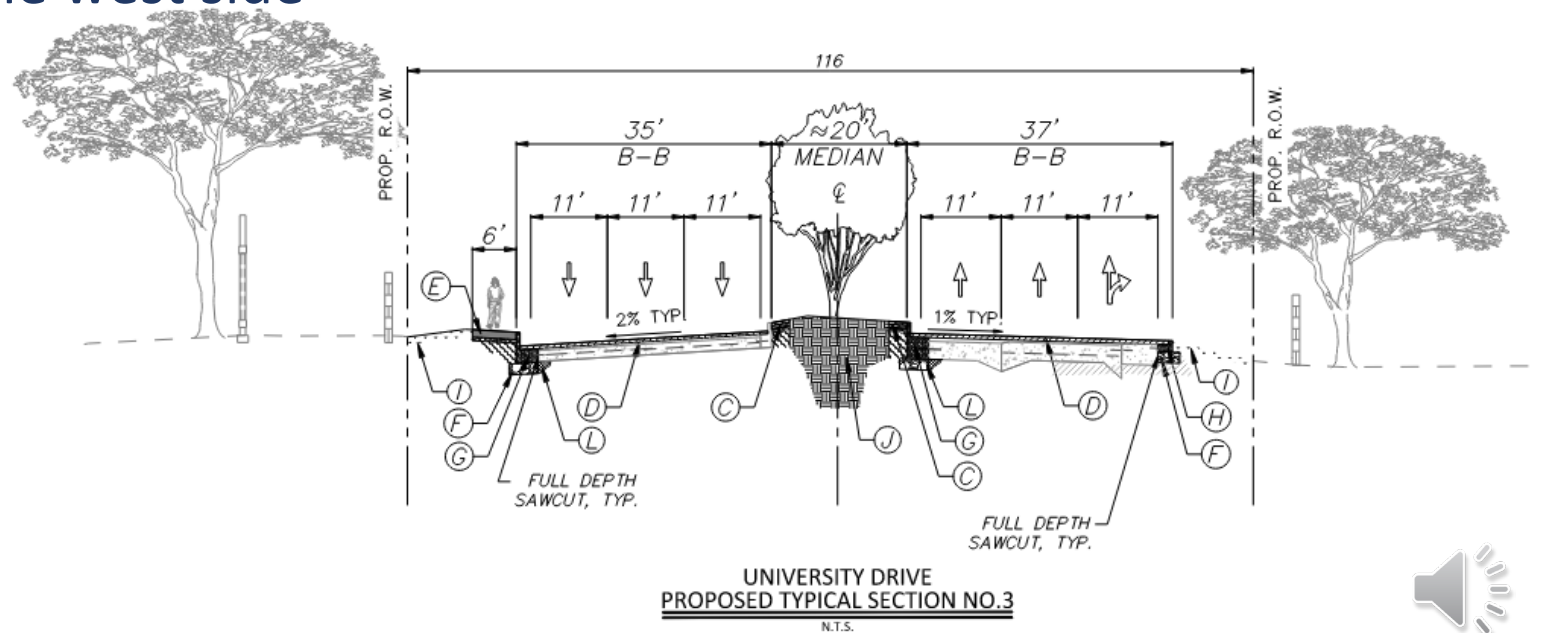
# Existing Section

- Existing pavement of variable total width
- 3 northbound lanes, 3 southbound lanes, and TWLTL
- Roadside ditches
- Variable ROW



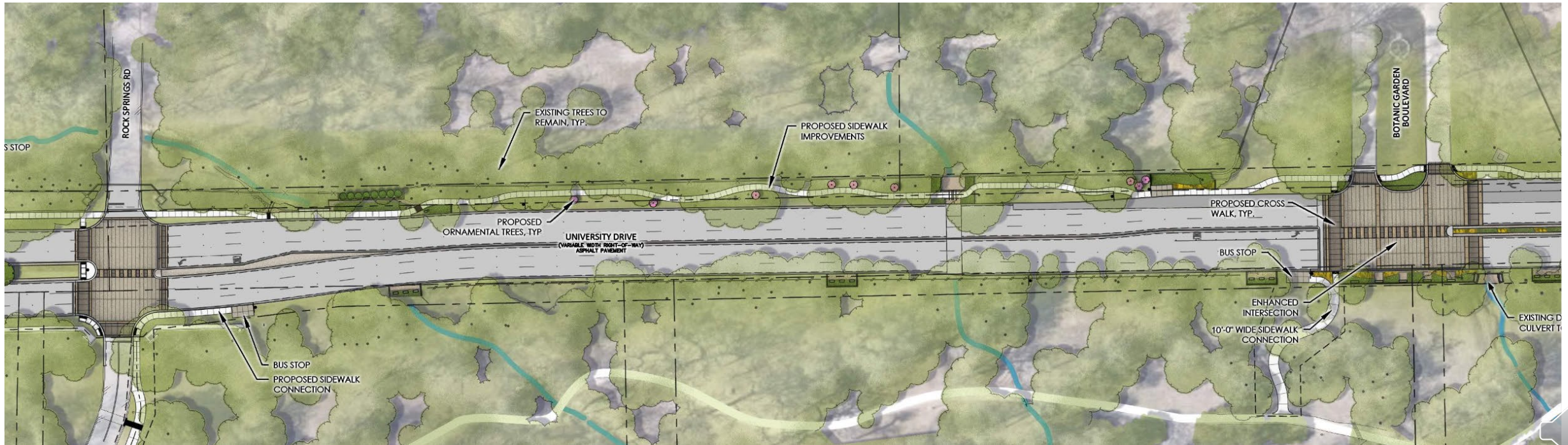
# Proposed Section

- 3 northbound 11-foot lanes, 3 southbound 11-foot lanes
- Variable width raised median
- A new six-foot sidewalk on the west side
- Landscaping
- Variable ROW from 116 feet to 145 feet



# Signal Improvements

- New traffic signals at Botanic Garden Blvd and Rock Springs Road intersections



## *Project Schedule*

- Currently in design phase: 60% stage
- Estimated construction start date: Summer 2026
- Estimated construction completion: Summer 2027





## *Project Funding & Costs*

- Federally funded through TxDOT
- Estimated construction cost: \$8.5M
