- Share the results.

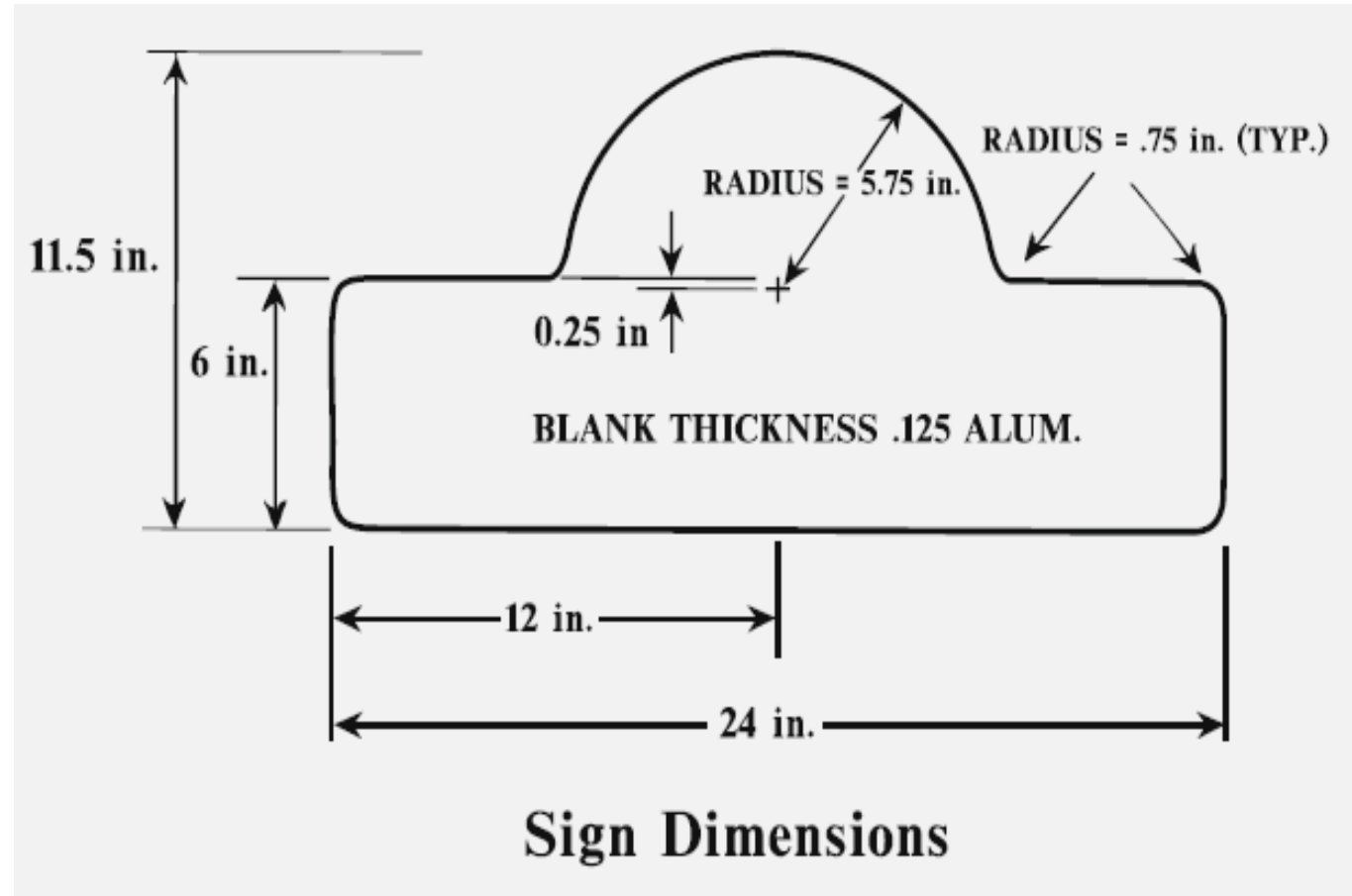

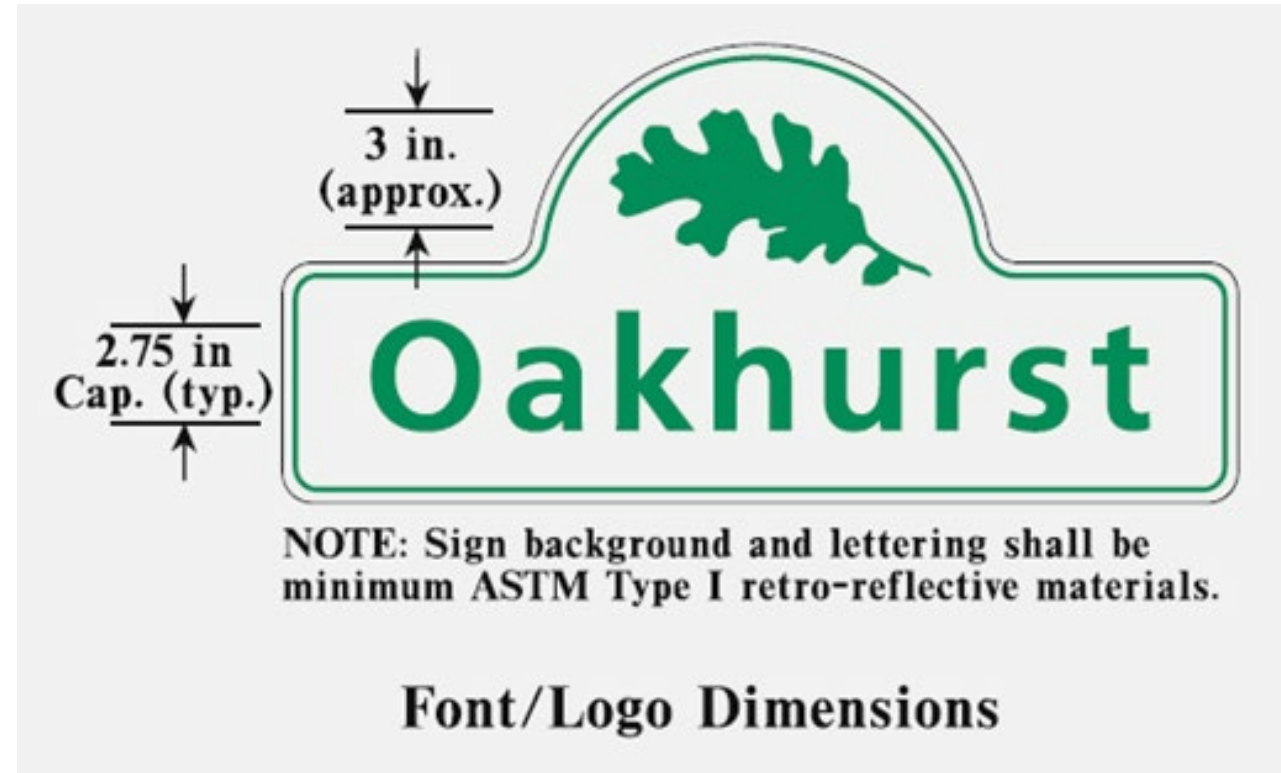

City sets shape and size.



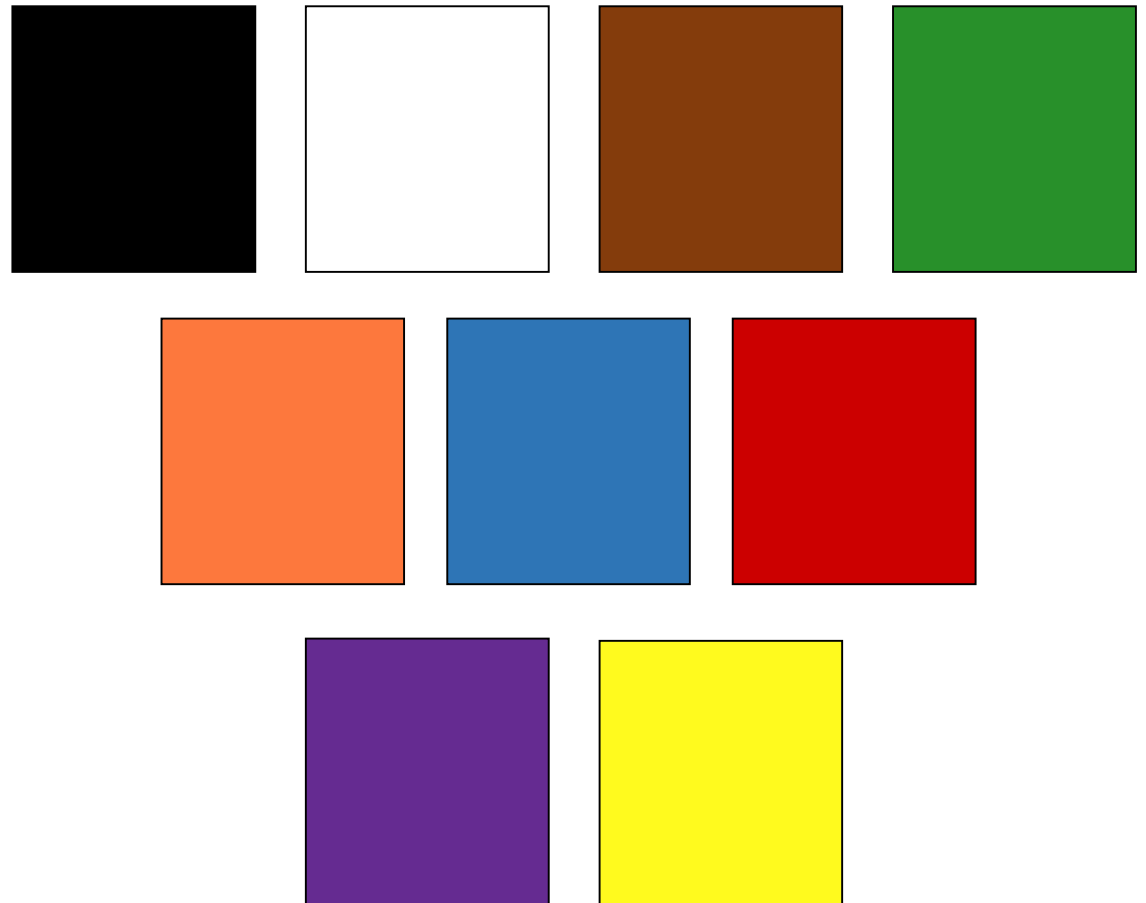
# How it works

## What it costs

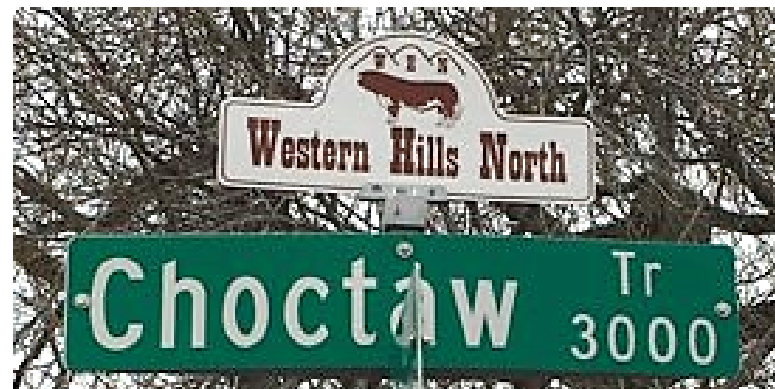
Range: \$75 - \$250 per sign
